- From 2006-2009 served as Secretary General of Sport in the Ministry of Culture of the Hellenic Republic.
- He is also an associate Professor in the Department of Physical Education And Sport Science at the University of Athens.
- He has served sport from various positions, as an athlete, coach and referee, in the sports of basketball, volleyball, football, and tennis.
- He has been an international referee, with participation in Olympic Games, World Championships and Championships of all five continents.
- For ten consecutive years, he has been the captain of the Greek National Tennis Team, in Davis Cup.
- He has been Vice President of the Technical Commission of FIBA World and FIBA Europe, as well as an International FIBA Instructor.
- He is also a member of the Executive Committee of the International University Sports Federation (FISU).
- He was Deputy President of the organizing committee of the Athens 2011 Special Olympics.
- In Greek Sport he was President of the Central Referee Commission of the Hellenic Basketball Federation. Since 2001, he offered his services in the Organizing Committee for the Olympic Games "Athens 2004", as Management consultant and since fall of 2003, as a Competition Manager for the sport of Basketball.
- He speaks English, French and Italian.
